THERE ARE MANY homeless mothers and children in Brevard County. The desperate phone calls come in every day from women who have NO JOB, NO INCOME, NO TRANSPORTATION, NO CHILD-CARE SERVICE, NO SUPPORT SYSTEM, and NOT ENOUGH EDUCATION TO BECOME EMPLOYED AND SELF-SUFFICIENT. Some of our callers are in abusive situations. This is the reality of the many women who call Genesis House for help.

We are able to provide shelter for many of the callers. Frequently we refer callers to other appropriate organizations such as Daily Bread, Brevard C.A.R.E.S, DCF, and Salvation Army.

We are now in our 37th year. We have helped over 14,000 women and children. We have 45 beds and cribs in our three shelter homes. This past year 248 residents have been sheltered with 10,641 nights of occupied beds. We provide our residents with safe, comfortable shelter, individual and group counseling, loving and supportive caring, and encouragement. The residents often start by improving their education, others find jobs, improve their family relationships, learn parenting skills, and get their lives back on track. We don't preach to our residents, but we show them God's love through our actions and positive, accepting attitude toward them while helping them. They often find their way to attending and joining a church. We work diligently to lead our residents into making positive changes in their lives.

I am grateful for all the donations, volunteer help, and the projects that have improved our shelter homes this year. Through your help and donations, we have been able to build a private counseling area at Genesis House II and install a circular driveway at Genesis House I.

This year we have had 15 teenage volunteers, 10 Webster University interns working on their Master's Degrees in counseling, and many individuals, churches, and organizations who gave generously of their time and talents. We continue to need your financial help and donations of volunteer time and projects. Thank you for your support and prayers.


